OCTOBER TOURNAMENT: Saturday, the 14th October at the Landings

Food will be available for purchase from Glory Days Grill from 11 am - 1 pm. We'll also have the restrooms at the Pool Clubhouse available the day of the tournament.

Regular Saturday play will be available on courts 1 and 2

We need more women to register, especially in the Mixed Doubles category.

Play for Mixed Doubles will begin at 8 am and will wrap up around 10:30 am. Men's and Women's Doubles will begin by 10 am and conclude around 2 pm.

The **last day to sign up** for the tournament is **October 9** and you must be current in your membership fees. Use this link to <u>register</u>.

Play will be contested in 3 categories:

- Men's Doubles
- · Women's Double and
- Mixed Doubles.

Depending on enrollment, there will be up to four divisions in each category:

- 1. All Ages All Skill levels
- 2. Ages 50 and over (or 50-60 and 60 and over if there are more than 8 teams)
- 3. Skill level below 3.5
- 4. Skill level 3.5 and above (or 3.5 and 4.0 if there are more than 8 teams)

President's Comments - Jon Weber



Everyone wants to know what is happening with the Court Conversion project. I have attended several Board of Trustees (BOT) meetings, answered their questions, and tried to state our case for conversion priorities. I just received budget numbers, so we have a good idea of what is available at this time. The BOT knows that there are insufficient funds to do the whole project at once. Consequently, they want to proceed in stages. We have proposed getting perimeter lighting as our top priority while continuing to use our portable nets. With shorter days, we will be able to play on more courts with lighting. When I know more, I will share it.

After completion of the 14 Oct Tournament, we plan to start using PCKL Elite 40 balls at the Landings. They play similarly to the Franklin X-40 balls we currently have, but reviews suggest that they are more durable as well as resisting cracking better at temperatures below 40°F.

Please review the BCPA Rules for Waiting on the <u>Rules</u> page, item 11 under Local Rules. There has been some confusion about our stacking method of determining next on court. If your paddle is not in the stack, you are not in line. BCPA rules also require names on the paddles so we can quickly identify who is next. The idea of the stacking is to constantly mix players of different skill levels and allow you to partner with many different members. Always keep in mind Local Rule item 1 – Keep it Friendly and Fun while playing.

If there are about four paddles in the stack when you arrive, and there are courts without nets setup, please go to our locker, get out a net, and enlist waiting players to help you set up a net on that court. We don't have permanent nets, so we must set up our portable nets. There are also usually blowers available to use to blow off the courts.

Fall Festival September 9-10 – You made it a success!


Spotlight on Andy Forsyth:

Security Note! Keep our Equipment Safe



REMINDER: Please continue to lock up all BCPA equipment. If you are one of the final 8 players or if you are independently playing using BCPA equipment it is vital that you check with the other players before leaving and make sure everything is put away. When you open the two locks on an equipment box, as soon as the lock opens, spin all 4 dials on each lock. You can close these locks even after spinning the dials. If you lock up, spin the dials again to be sure. We haven't had any more recent security incidents reported but if you see an issue, please let one of the <u>Board Members</u> know.

Playtime Scheduler and Court Access

BCPA uses Playtime Scheduler to invite members to play events and to get out quick updates on items of interest affecting our club. It works best when you use it. **Burke Centre Key Holders** are strongly encouraged to use Playtime Scheduler and sign up to arrive at (or slightly prior to) the scheduled start time. Also, the notes may include any late breaking changes or alerts about parking, location so a glance at those may prevent a surprise. We have a few regular openers but if they are not available people may wind up waiting at the gate until a key holder can arrive. Using Playtime Scheduler on a consistent basis really helps set expectations for the club. Instructions for signing up and using Scheduler can be downloaded from BCPA's <u>News</u> page.
